A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

High–Risk Pregnancy Reimbursement Fund – Establishment

FOR the purpose of establishing the High-Risk Pregnancy Reimbursement Fund as a
special, nonlapsing fund to provide reimbursement to individuals for unforeseen
out-of-pocket health care costs related to the individual's high-risk pregnancy;
requiring interest earnings of the Fund to be credited to the Fund; authorizing an
individual to apply for reimbursement from the Fund if the individual provides
certain documentation and applies within a certain time period; and generally
relating to the High-Risk Pregnancy Reimbursement Fund.

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1 (G) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND 2 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.

3 (2) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO
 4 THE FUND.

5 (H) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE 6 WITH THE STATE BUDGET.

7 (I) MONEY EXPENDED FROM THE FUND FOR CARRYING OUT THE PURPOSE 8 OF THE FUND IS SUPPLEMENTAL TO AND IS NOT INTENDED TO TAKE THE PLACE OF 9 FUNDING THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE APPROPRIATED FOR CARRYING OUT THE 10 PURPOSE OF THE FUND.

12 (A) AN INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE 13 FUND IF THE INDIVIDUAL:

14 (1) PROVIDES DOCUMENTATION FROM A PHYSICIAN OR OTHER 15 HEALTH CARE PROVIDER WHO PROVIDED HEALTH CARE SERVICES TO THE 16 INDIVIDUAL DURING THE PREGNANCY THAT THE PREGNANCY IS HIGH–RISK FOR 17 THE PREGNANT INDIVIDUAL, THE FETUS, OR BOTH;

18(2) PROVIDES DOCUMENTATION THAT THE INDIVIDUAL PAID19OUT-OF-POCKET COSTS FOR HEALTH CARE SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE20PREGNANCY THAT WERE NOT COVERED OR REIMBURSED BY INSURANCE; AND

21(3)APPLIES TO THE FUND FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF ELIGIBLE COSTS22WITHIN 6 MONTHS AFTER THE BIRTH OF THE CHILD OR LOSS OF THE PREGNANCY.

(B) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO APPLIES FOR REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE FUND
 MAY RECEIVE A REIMBURSEMENT NOT EXCEEDING \$25,000 FOR EACH HIGH-RISK
 PREGNANCY.

FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$2,500,000 TO THE FUND.

2 (a) (2) (i) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and unless 3 inconsistent with a federal law, grant agreement, or other federal requirement or with the 4 terms of a gift or settlement agreement, net interest on all State money allocated by the 5 State Treasurer under this section to special funds or accounts, and otherwise entitled to 6 receive interest earnings, as accounted for by the Comptroller, shall accrue to the General 7 Fund of the State.

8 (ii) The provisions of subparagraph (i) of this paragraph do not apply 9 to the following funds: 10 189. the Teacher Retention and Development Fund; [and] the Protecting Against Hate Crimes Grant Fund; AND 11 190. 12**191.** THE HIGH-RISK PREGNANCY REIMBURSEMENT 13FUND.
