1 AN ACT concerning

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Public Health - Tianeptine Consumer Protection Act

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a retailer that prepares, distributes, sells, or exposes for sale a food that is represented to be a tianeptine product to disclose the factual basis on 4 5 which the representation is made; prohibiting a retailer from preparing, distributing, 6 selling, or exposing for sale tianeptine products that do not include certain 7 information; prohibiting a retailer from distributing, selling, or exposing for sale, or 8 advertising for sale a tianeptine product to an individual under a certain age; 9 prohibiting a retailer from directly or indirectly advertising tianeptine products to 10 miners; and generally relating to tianeptine and tianeptine retailers.
