SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (a) (1) Each county board may use volunteer aides in school activities in its 16 county.

17(2)A COUNTY BOARD MAY USE A CHAPLAIN AS A VOLUNTEER AIDE IN18SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE SUPPORT SERVICES TO STUDENTS.

- 19 (b) A volunteer aide may not be used to supplant educational personnel but shall 20 be used to assist regular employees in their assignments.
- 21 (c) Each county superintendent shall establish guidelines for the use of volunteer
