17	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18	That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21	(a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
22	(o) (1) "Provide esthetic services" means to provide to an individual, for
23	compensation, the service of:



1	[(1)] (I) cleansing, exercising, EXFOLIATING, massaging, COSMETIC
2 3	MICRONEEDLING, stimulating, TONING, or performing any other similar procedure or the skin or scalp by electrical, mechanical, or any other means;
4 5	[(2)] (II) applying to the face, BODY, OR SCALP an alcohol, cream, lotion astringent, or cosmetic preparation; or
6 7	[(3)] (III) removing superfluous hair by the use of [a depilatory, tweezers or wax] ELECTRICAL, MECHANICAL, OR ANY OTHER MEANS.
8	(2) "PROVIDE ESTHETIC SERVICES" INCLUDES:
9	(I) APPLYING MAKEUP;
10	(II) APPLYING EYELASH EXTENSIONS;
11	(III) PERFORMING SUPERFICIAL EXFOLIATION TREATMENTS OF
12 13	THE EPIDERMIS USING PROFESSIONAL AND OTHER COMMERCIALLY AVAILABLE PRODUCTS OR DEVICES;
14	(IV) PERFORMING TREATMENTS FOR THE RELAXATION

18	(3) "PROVIDE ESTHETIC SERVICES" DOES NOT INCLUDE:
