- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF

- 20 CORRECTIONAL FACILITY WHO SERVES IN THE CLASSIFICATION OF:
- 21 (1) LIEUTENANT;
- 22 **(2)** CAPTAIN;

- 2 (4) CASE MANAGEMENT SUPERVISOR OR MANAGER.
- 3 (B) IF A PAY INCREASE UNDER THE STATE STANDARD PAY PLAN IS LIMITED
 4 TO EMPLOYEES IN BARGAINING UNIT H FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND SECURITY
 5 PERSONNEL, AN EMPLOYEE UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION WHO IS NOT
 6 IN THE BARGAINING UNIT SHALL RECEIVE A PROPORTIONATE PAY INCREASE, BASED
 7 ON RANK AND LENGTH OF SERVICE, INCLUDING LONGEVITY PAY.
- 8 (C) AN EMPLOYEE SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL RECEIVE RETENTION
 9 AND LONGEVITY BENEFITS THAT ARE LIMITED TO OTHER CLASSIFICATIONS IF THE
 10 EMPLOYEE WOULD OTHERWISE BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE BENEFITS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
