- 5 FOR the purpose of requiring each village community association for a village of Columbia 6 to require each candidate for election to the village board or the Columbia Council 7 who receives donations or makes disbursements to file reports of the donations and 8 disbursements with the village community association; requiring each village 9 community association to make the reports of donations and disbursements available 10 to the public; prohibiting a candidate for election to a village board or the Columbia 11 Council who is elected from taking office if the candidate has failed to file a report of 12 donations and disbursements; and generally relating to reports of donations and disbursements by candidates for village board or Columbia Council in a village of 13 Columbia. 14

(F) EACH VILLAGE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION MAY ADOPT ANY PROVISION NECESSARY TO ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2024.
