14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18	(a)	In this section, "handgun" means a firearm:	
19		(1)	With a barrel length not exceeding 6 inches; and
20		(2)	That does not have a scope or an electronic device attached.

1 (i) Prescribe by regulation the means or weapons for hunting 2 designated wildlife; and

3 (ii) Set forth any restrictions relating to weapons used to hunt 4 designated wildlife, including the amount and size of ammunition for designated game 5 birds or mammals.

6 (2) The Department may not prohibit a licensed bow hunter from openly 7 carrying a handgun that the hunter is otherwise authorized to carry under § 4–203 of the 8 Criminal Law Article if the bow hunter:

- 9 (i) Is at least 21 years old;
- 10 (ii) Is hunting in [deer]:

11 **1. DEER** management Region A as defined by the 12 Department's Guide to Hunting and Trapping; **OR**

132.FREDERICK COUNTY OR WASHINGTON COUNTY14DURING DEER HUNTING SEASON;

15 (iii) Is carrying the handgun for personal protection; and

16 (iv) Does not use the handgun to kill wildlife wounded by a vertical17 bow or crossbow.

18 (c) The Department shall make the regulations available for distribution with 19 each hunting license purchased.

20 (d) This section does not authorize the Department to restrict the use of firearms 21 except in the activity of hunting designated wildlife.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 23 1, 2024.
