- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 17 (A) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2025, THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL

- 5 (C) A PUBLIC SCHOOL MAY PARTNER WITH A LOCAL PARKS AND 6 RECREATION AGENCY TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO THE NECESSARY WATER AND 7 SWIMMING FACILITIES FOR THE COURSE OFFERED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS 8 SECTION.
- 9 (D) THE STATE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 10 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
