Vehicle Laws - Damaged, Obscured, or Modified Registration Plates

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to offer during the registration renewal process to replace vehicle registration plates that are more than a certain age; altering the prohibition against obscuring or modifying a vehicle registration plate by prohibiting such activity in a manner that may prevent identification; altering the penalty and points assessment for obscuring or modifying a vehicle registration plate; and generally relating to damaged, obscured, or modified vehicle registration plates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 2 That Section(s) 16–402(a)(17) through (43) of Article – Transportation of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 16-402(a)(18) through (44), respectively. 3 SECTION 2.  - (1) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, ISSUED A WARNING NOTICE; AND

- 5 (2) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, ASSESSED POINTS 6 UNDER § 16–402 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2024.
