


- 4 FOR the purpose of establishing the High Impact Development Project Program within the 5 Department of Commerce to provide certain financial assistance to certain industrial 6 development agencies or enterprises undertaking high impact, placemaking projects 7 that will support certain manufacturing activities; requiring the Department to 8 award financial assistance to certain entities carrying out high impact development 9 projects under certain circumstances and subject to certain limitations; establishing 10 a High Impact Development Project Account within the Maryland Economic 11 Development Assistance Fund; and generally relating to the Maryland Economic 12 Development Assistance Authority and Fund and the High Impact Development 13 Project Program.
