BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Health Occupations Section 19–101(a) and (b) Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Health Occupations Section 19–202(a), 19–302.1, and 19–309(d)(6) Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Health Occupations**
