8 (b) (1)A person may not, with the intent to commit a violation of § 3–304 or § 9 3-307 of this subtitle or § 11-207, § 11-303, § 11-304, § 11-305, § 11-306, or § 11-307 of this article, knowingly solicit a minor, or a law enforcement officer posing as a minor, to 10 11 engage in activities that would be unlawful for the person to engage in under § 3–304 or § 123-307 of this subtitle or § 11-207, § 11-303, § 11-304, § 11-305, § 11-306, or § 11-307 of 13 this article.
