20 (2) REMAIN POSTED ONLINE UNTIL AT LEAST 30 DAYS AFTER THE 21 CENTRAL COMMITTEE VOTES ON AN INDIVIDUAL TO FILL THE VACANCY.

22 (D) THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE SHALL HOLD A PUBLIC MEETING TO 23 INTERVIEW THE INDIVIDUALS WHO APPLIED TO FILL THE VACANCY.

24 (E) A MEETING HELD BY A CENTRAL COMMITTEE TO DISCUSS OR VOTE ON 25 FILLING A VACANCY SHALL BE:

- 26 (1) OPEN TO THE PUBLIC; AND
- 27 (2) ANNOUNCED AT LEAST 3 DAYS BEFORE THE MEETING.

28 **(F) (1)** THE VOTE BY A CENTRAL COMMITTEE TO CHOOSE AN INDIVIDUAL 29 TO FILL A VACANCY SHALL BE:

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1 (I) BY ROLL CALL VOTE OR BY SIGNED BALLOTS; AND

(II) IN A MEETING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

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3 (2) A MEMBER OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE WHO HAS APPLIED TO
4 FILL THE VACANCY SHALL RECUSE THEMSELVES FROM VOTING ON THE INDIVIDUAL
5 TO FILL THE VACANCY.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2024.
