A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – Coaches – Mental Health Training**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education, in collaboration with the
4 Maryland Department of Health, each county board of education, and the Maryland
5 Public Secondary Schools Athletic Association, to develop guidelines for public
6 schools to train coaches to recognize indicators of mental illness and behavioral
7 distress in students; requiring each public school in the State that offers a
8 mainstream athletic program to provide a certain mental health training to coaches;
9 requiring the Maryland Higher Education Commission, in collaboration with the
10 Maryland Department of Health, to develop guidelines for public institutions of
11 higher education to train coaches to recognize indicators of mental illness and
12 behavioral distress in students; requiring a public institution of higher education
13 that offers an athletic program to provide a certain mental health training to
14 coaches; and generally relating to coaches and mental health training.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Education**

23 **7–452.**

1 (A) IN THIS SECTION, “MAINSTREAM ATHLETIC PROGRAM” MEANS AN
2 INTRAMURAL OR INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETIC ACTIVITY THAT IS DEVELOPED AND
3 OFFERED TO STUDENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE
4 STATE BOARD.

5 (B) THE DEPARTMENT, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE MARYLAND
6 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, EACH COUNTY BOARD, AND THE MARYLAND PUBLIC
7 SECONDARY SCHOOLS ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, SHALL DEVELOP GUIDELINES FOR
8 PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO TRAIN COACHES TO RECOGNIZE INDICATORS OF MENTAL
9 ILLNESS AND BEHAVIORAL DISTRESS IN STUDENTS, INCLUDING:

10 (1) DEPRESSION;

11 (2) TRAUMA;

12 (3) VIOLENCE;

13 (4) YOUTH SUICIDE; AND

14 (5) SUBSTANCE ABUSE.

15 (C) EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE STATE THAT OFFERS A MAINSTREAM
16 ATHLETIC PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE TRAINING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
17 GUIDELINES DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO EACH COACH
18 PARTICIPATING IN THE MAINSTREAM ATHLETIC PROGRAM.

20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, “ATHLETIC PROGRAM” MEANS ANY
21 INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETIC PROGRAM AT A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
22 EDUCATION IN THE STATE.

23 (B) THE COMMISSION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE MARYLAND
24 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, SHALL DEVELOP GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC
25 INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO TRAIN COACHES TO RECOGNIZE
26 INDICATORS OF MENTAL ILLNESS AND BEHAVIORAL DISTRESS IN STUDENTS,
27 INCLUDING:

28 (1) DEPRESSION;

29 (2) TRAUMA;

30 (3) VIOLENCE;

1 **(4) YOUTH SUICIDE; AND**

2 **(5) SUBSTANCE ABUSE.**

3 **(C) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT OFFERS AN**
4 **ATHLETIC PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE TRAINING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE**
5 **GUIDELINES DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION TO EACH COACH**
6 **PARTICIPATING IN THE ATHLETIC PROGRAM.**

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
8 1, 2024.
