State Procurement - Prompt Payment of Suppliers

1 AN ACT concerning

- FOR the purpose of providing that certain provisions requiring prompt payments for State procurement contracts apply to payments owed by a contractor or subcontractor to a
- supplier; and generally relating to the prompt payment of suppliers that have
- 6 supplied labor or materials for work done under State procurement contracts.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 16 (a) (1) In this section[, "undisputed] THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE
- 17 MEANINGS INDICATED.
- 18 (2) "SUPPLIER" MEANS A PERSON THAT HAS SUPPLIED LABOR OR
- 19 MATERIALS TO A CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR IN THE PROSECUTION OF
- 20 WORK PROVIDED FOR IN A STATE PROCUREMENT CONTRACT.

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

- "UNDISPUTED amount" means an amount owed by a contractor to a 1 **(3)** 2 subcontractor OR SUPPLIER for which there is no good faith dispute, including any 3 retainage withheld. 4 It is the policy of the State that, for work under a State procurement contract: a contractor shall promptly pay to a subcontractor OR SUPPLIER any 5 6 undisputed amount to which the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER is entitled; and 7 (2)a subcontractor shall promptly pay to a lower tier subcontractor OR 8 SUPPLIER any undisputed amount to which the lower tier subcontractor is entitled. 9 (c) (1)A contractor shall pay a subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** an undisputed 10 amount to which the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** is entitled within 10 days of receiving a 11 progress or final payment from the State. 12 If a contractor withholds payment from a subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER**, within the time period in which payment normally would be made, the contractor shall: 13 14 notify the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER in writing and state the 15 reason why payment is being withheld; and 16 (ii) provide a copy of the notice to the procurement officer. 17 (d) If a subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** does not receive a payment within the (1)18 required time period, the subcontractor OR SUPPLIER may give written notice of the nonpayment to the procurement officer. 19 20 (2)The notice shall: 21indicate the name of the contractor, the project under which the 22dispute exists, and the amount in dispute; 23 provide an itemized description on which the amount is based; (ii) 24and 25if known, provide an explanation for any dispute concerning (iii) 26 payment by the contractor. 27 Within 2 business days of receipt of written notice from a subcontractor (e)
- 31 (2) If the representative of the unit decides that a part or all of the amount 32 withheld is an undisputed amount, the representative of the unit shall instruct the

OR SUPPLIER, a representative of the unit designated by the procurement officer shall

verbally contact the contractor to ascertain whether the amount withheld is an undisputed

- 1 contractor to pay the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** the undisputed amount within 3 business days.
- 3 (3) The representative of the unit shall verbally communicate to the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** the results of discussions with the contractor.
- 5 (4) If the contractor is instructed to pay the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** 6 and the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** is not paid within the time instructed under 7 paragraph (2) of this subsection, the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** may report the 8 nonpayment in writing to the procurement officer.
- 9 (f) (1) If the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** notifies the procurement officer 10 under subsection (e)(4) of this section that payment has not been made, the representative 11 of the unit shall schedule a meeting to discuss the dispute with the unit's project manager, 12 the contractor, and the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER**:
- 13 (i) at a time and location designated by the representative of the 14 unit; but
- 15 (ii) not later than 10 days after receiving notice from the 16 subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** under subsection (e)(4) of this section.
- 17 (2) The purpose of the meeting is to establish why the contractor has not paid the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** in the required time period.
- 19 (3) The representative of the unit shall require the parties to provide at the 20 meeting any information that the representative believes necessary to evaluate the dispute.
- 21 (4) If the representative of the unit determines that the contractor is 22 delinquent in payment of an undisputed amount to the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER**, 23 further progress payments to the contractor may be withheld until the subcontractor **OR** 24 **SUPPLIER** is paid.
- 25 (5) If payment is not paid to the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** within 7 days 26 after the representative of the unit determines that the contractor is delinquent in paying 27 the subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER** under this subsection, the representative shall schedule 28 a second meeting to address the dispute:
- 29 (i) at a time and location designated by the representative of the 30 unit; but
- 31 (ii) not later than 5 days after the close of the 7-day period.
- 32 (6) If, at the completion of the second meeting, the representative of the 33 unit determines that the contractor continues to be delinquent in payments owed to the 34 subcontractor **OR SUPPLIER**, the representative:



(2) The contract provision shall establish procedures and remedies for the resolution of payment disputes similar to the process and remedies prescribed in subsections (c) through (g) of this section.

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SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2024.
