SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and applies only after the next vacancy occurs on the Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland after the effective date of this Act.
SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024 .
