CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **University System of Maryland – Board of Regents – Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that certain appointing officials in making appointments to
4 the Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland ensure that one member
5 of the Board is a graduate of a historically Black college or university in the ~~State~~
6 University System of Maryland; and generally relating to the membership of the
7 Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Education**

2 (b) The government of the University System of Maryland is vested in the Board
3 of Regents of the University System of Maryland.

4 (c) The Board of Regents consists of 21 members as follows:

5 (1) (i) Except as provided in item (ii) of this item, two members shall be
6 full-time students in good academic standing at an institution under the jurisdiction of the
7 Board; and

8 (ii) A student member who is in good academic standing at the
9 University of Maryland Global Campus shall be exempt from the full-time student
10 requirement in item (i) of this item;

11 (2) One member shall be the Secretary of Agriculture ex officio;

12 (3) One member shall be the Secretary of Commerce ex officio;

13 (4) One member shall be appointed by the President of the Senate;

14 (5) One member shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House; and

15 (6) The remaining members of the Board shall [be]:

16 (I) **BE** residents of the State[, shall be];

17 (II) **BE** appointed from the general public[, and shall include]; **AND**

18 (III) **INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS:**

19 [(i)] 1. One individual with a background in higher education
20 administration;

21 [(ii)] 2. One individual with a background in finance; and

22 [(iii)] 3. One individual with a background in diversity and
23 workplace inclusion.

24 (d) In making appointments to the Board, the Governor, the President of the
25 Senate, and the Speaker of the House shall [consider]:

26 (1) **ENSURE THAT ONE MEMBER OF THE BOARD IS A GRADUATE OF A**
27 **HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY IN THE ~~STATE~~ UNIVERSITY**
28 **SYSTEM OF MARYLAND; AND**

1 **(2) CONSIDER** representation from all parts of the State.

2 (e) (1) Each member of the Board appointed under subsection (c)(1) and (6) of
3 this section shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate.

4 (2) After the 40th day, and before the 80th day, from the commencement of
5 each regular session of the General Assembly, the Senate shall consider each year's
6 appointees to the Board collectively to ensure adequate balance of membership.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to
8 apply only prospectively and applies only after the next vacancy occurs on the Board of
9 Regents of the University System of Maryland after the effective date of this Act.

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
11 1, 2024.
