4 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
5 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 **Article – Health Occupations**

7 1A-201.

8 There is a State Acupuncture Board in the Department.

9 1A-502.

10 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program
11 Evaluation Act, this title and all rules and regulations adopted under this title shall
12 terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2025] ~~2028~~ 2030.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
14 1, 2024.
