4 FOR the purpose of continuing the Behavior Analyst Advisory Committee within the State
5 Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists in accordance with the provisions
6 of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset law) by extending to a certain date
7 the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the
8 Committee; and generally relating to the Behavior Analyst Advisory Committee
9 within the State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health Occupations

17–201.

There is a State Board of Professional Counselors and Therapists.

17–6A–05.

There is a Behavior Analyst Advisory Committee within the Board.

17–6A–31.

Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the **MARYLAND** Program Evaluation Act, this subtitle and all rules and regulations adopted under this subtitle shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2024] **2026**.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2024.
