BY renumbering Article – State Government Section 8–403(13) through (64) to be Section 8–403(14) through (65), respectively Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Health – General Section 19–2102 Annotated Code of Maryland (2023 Replacement Volume)
