3 FOR the purpose of altering provisions relating to the membership of, and the terms of
4 members appointed to, adult public guardianship review boards; and generally
5 relating to adult protective services.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Family Law**

14 14–402.

15 (a) (1) Each review board consists of [11] 8 members **RECRUITED AND**
16 appointed:

17 (i) by the county commissioners;

1 (ii) in Baltimore City, by the Mayor with the advice and consent of
2 the City Council;

3 (iii) in any county that has a county executive, by the county
4 executive with the advice and consent of the county council; or

5 (iv) if 2 or more counties have agreed to establish a multicounty
6 review board, jointly by the appropriate officials of the counties served by the board.

7 (2) Of the [11] 8 members:

8 (i) 1 shall be a professional representative of a local department;

9 [(ii) 1. in counties other than St. Mary's County or Washington
10 County:

11 A.] (II) 1 shall be a physician's assistant, nurse
12 practitioner, REGISTERED NURSE, or physician who is not a psychiatrist; [and]

13 [B.] (III) 1 shall be a psychiatrist, A PSYCHIATRIC NURSE
14 PRACTITIONER, OR A PROFESSIONAL WITH EXPERTISE IN PRESCRIBING OR
15 OVERSIGHT OF MENTAL HEALTH MEDICATIONS; [and

16 2. in St. Mary's County and Washington County:

17 A. 1 shall be a physician's assistant, nurse practitioner, or
18 physician who is not a psychiatrist; and

19 B. 1 shall be a psychiatrist or psychologist;

20 [(iii)] (IV) 1 shall be a representative of a local commission on aging;

21 [(iv)] (V) 1 shall be a professional representative of a local nonprofit
22 social service organization;

23 [(v)] (VI) 1 shall be a lawyer;

24 [(vi)] (VII) [2] 1 shall be A lay [individuals] INDIVIDUAL; AND

25 [(vii) 1 shall be a registered nurse;]

26 (viii) 1 shall be a professional in the field of disabilities[; and] OR A
27 PERSON WITH A DISABILITY.

28 [(ix) 1 shall be a person with a physical disability.]

1 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph [(3)] (2) of this subsection, the term
2 of a member is 3 years.

3 [(2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided
4 for members of the review board on October 1, 1984.

5 (3) (2) In Charles County, the term of a member is 4 years.

6 [(4)] (3) At the end of a term, a member [continues to serve until a
7 successor is appointed and qualifies] **MAY SERVE FOR ANOTHER TERM ON**
8 **APPOINTMENT.**

9 [(5)] (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only
10 for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2024.
