

- 9 (g) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person may **TRIM**, 10 harvest, cut, or otherwise remove or eradicate submerged aquatic vegetation from any land 11 under the tidal waters of the State below mean high tide only in accordance with a plan 12 approved by the Department.
- 13 (2) The plan under this subsection shall include the following 14 requirements:
- 15 (i) The name, address, and telephone number of the person making 16 the request;
- 17 (ii) A written description by the person making the request of the reasons why it is necessary to **ALTER OR** remove the submerged aquatic vegetation;
- 19 (iii) The proposed method to **ALTER OR** remove the submerged 20 aquatic vegetation; and
- 21 (iv) A diagram showing the location and extent of the submerged 22 aquatic vegetation that is proposed to be **ALTERED OR** removed.
- 23 (h) The authorization required by this section is in addition to any other permit 24 or license required by law.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
