1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read 2 as follows:

#### **Article – Public Safety**

5 (A) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2024, AND EACH OCTOBER 1 THEREAFTER, 6 THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE MARYLAND JUDICIARY SHALL REPORT TO 7 THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT 8 ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON THE NUMBER OF CHARGES, CONVICTIONS, 9 AND SENTENCES FOR VIOLATIONS OF § 4–203 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE AND 10 § 5–133(D) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

## 11 **(B)** THE INFORMATION INCLUDED IN THE REPORT SHALL BE 12 DISAGGREGATED BY JURISDICTION, RACE, AND GENDER.

13 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June14 1, 2024.
