2 Health Occupations – Private Dental Offices – Infection Control

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring each owner of a private dental office to designate a licensed dentist to be the supervising dentist for the private dental office; requiring a 4 $\mathbf{5}$ supervising dentist to complete the registration required by the State Board of 6 Dental Examiners and be responsible for all infection control activities within the 7 private dental office; establishing a certain limit on the number of private dental 8 offices that a supervising dentist may supervise; requiring the owner of a private 9 dental office to designate an interim supervising dentist under certain 10 circumstances; authorizing the Board to charge a certain registration fee; and 11 generally relating to infection control in private dental offices.
