- FOR the purpose of authorizing Baltimore City to tow, remove, or impound a vehicle owned by a new resident of the State who fails to register the vehicle with the Motor Vehicle Administration and display valid registration plates issued by the Administration within a certain time period; and generally relating to towing, removal, and impounding of improperly registered out—of—state vehicles in Baltimore City.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 22 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section or elsewhere in the
- 23 Maryland Vehicle Law, each motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer driven on
- 24 a highway shall be registered under this subtitle.



- 1 (2) If a motor vehicle required to be registered under this subtitle is not 2 registered, a person may not park the unregistered motor vehicle on any:
- 3 (i) Public alley, street, or highway; or
- 4 (ii) Private property used by the public in general, including parking 5 lots of shopping centers, condominiums, apartments, or town house developments.
- 6 (3) The provisions of paragraph (2) of this subsection do not apply to a motor vehicle that is exempt from registration under this section or § 13–402.1 of this subtitle.

- 10 (7) A vehicle owned by a new resident of this State during the first 60 days of residency provided the vehicle displays valid registration issued by the jurisdiction of the resident's former domicile;

- 14 (b) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, any State agency authorized by law and any political subdivision of this State may adopt ordinances or regulations that:
- 16 (1) Regulate the parking of vehicles;
- 17 (2) Provide for the impounding of vehicles parked in violation of the 18 ordinances or regulations;
- 19 (3) Regulate the towing of vehicles from publicly owned and privately 20 owned parking lots; and
- 21 (4) Provide for the issuance of a citation by an officer for a violation of an ordinance or regulation that is adopted under this section.
- 23 (B-1) (1) This subsection applies only in Baltimore City.
- 24 (2) BALTIMORE CITY MAY TOW, REMOVE, OR IMPOUND A VEHICLE
 25 OWNED BY A NEW RESIDENT OF THE STATE WHO FAILS TO REGISTER THE VEHICLE
 26 WITH THE ADMINISTRATION AND DISPLAY VALID REGISTRATION PLATES ISSUED BY
 27 THE ADMINISTRATION WITHIN 60 DAYS AS REQUIRED UNDER § 13–402 OF THIS
 28 ARTICLE.
