CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Alcoholic Beverages – Retail Delivery – Local Delivery Service Permit

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a local delivery service permit that authorizes the holder 4 to deliver alcoholic beverages from a certain retail license holder that is authorized to deliver alcoholic beverages to purchasers in a certain jurisdiction under certain $\mathbf{5}$ 6 circumstances; authorizing certain retail license holders to deliver alcoholic 7 beverages to purchasers in a certain jurisdiction through a third-party contractor, 8 an independent contractor, or an agent that holds a certain delivery service permit 9 under certain circumstances; altering certain standards and requirements for the retail delivery of alcoholic beverages; and generally relating to retail delivery of 10 11 alcoholic beverages.

1 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN A JURISDICTION WHERE THE LOCAL 2 LICENSING BOARD HAS ADOPTED REGULATIONS TO AUTHORIZE THE DELIVERY OF 3 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY A THIRD-PARTY CONTRACTOR, AN INDEPENDENT 4 CONTRACTOR, OR AN AGENT.

5 (B) A LOCAL LICENSING BOARD MAY ISSUE A LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE 6 PERMIT.

7 (C) THE PERMIT AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO DELIVER ALCOHOLIC 8 BEVERAGES FROM A RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER AUTHORIZED TO DELIVER 9 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES UNDER § 4–507 OF THIS TITLE TO AN INDIVIDUAL IN THE 10 JURISDICTION WHERE THE RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER IS LOCATED.

11 (D) A LOCAL LICENSING BOARD MAY SET BY REGULATION:

12(1) THE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE LOCAL DELIVERY13SERVICE PERMIT; AND

14 (2) ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR HOLDERS OF THE LOCAL 15 DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT WHO DELIVER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON BEHALF OF 16 A RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER.

17 (E) (1) THE LOCAL LICENSING BOARD MAY CHARGE A FEE FOR THE 18 LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT.

19(2) THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT IS20 \$1,000.

21 (F) A LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT HOLDER MAY:

22 (1) USE THE DELIVERY SERVICE'S EMPLOYEES OR INDEPENDENT 23 CONTRACTORS WHO ARE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD TO DELIVER ALCOHOLIC 24 BEVERAGES; AND

25 (2) FACILITATE ORDERS FOR THE SALE AND DELIVERY OF 26 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY TELEPHONE, INTERNET, OR OTHER ELECTRONIC 27 MEANS.

28 (G) THE PURCHASER OR RECEIVER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES UNDER THIS 29 SECTION SHALL:

30 (1) BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD; AND

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1 (2) PROVIDE VALID IDENTIFICATION AS PROOF OF AGE ON RECEIPT 2 OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

3 (H) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES SOLD FOR OFF-PREMISES DELIVERY UNDER 4 THIS SECTION SHALL BE:

5 (1) PROVIDED IN THE MANUFACTURER'S ORIGINAL SEALED 6 CONTAINER; AND

7 (2) SOLD ONLY DURING THE HOURS THE RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER IS 8 OPEN FOR IN-STORE PURCHASES.

9 (I) AN INDIVIDUAL DELIVERING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES UNDER A LOCAL 10 DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT SHALL:

11 (1) BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD; AND

12 (2) HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED AN APPROVED ALCOHOL 13 AWARENESS PROGRAM UNDER § 4–505 OF THIS TITLE.

14 (J) A LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOT DELIVER 15 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO:

16 (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DOES NOT PROVIDE VALID IDENTIFICATION 17 PROVING THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD;

18(2) ANOTHER PREMISES LICENSED TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES;19OR

20 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL LOCATED OUTSIDE THE JURISDICTION WHERE 21 THE RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER IS LOCATED.

22 (K) A LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT HOLDER IS SUBJECT TO THE 23 FOLLOWING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATING THIS SECTION:

24 (1) FOR A FIRST VIOLATION, A FINE OF \$1,000;

25(2)FOR A SECOND VIOLATION, A FINE OF \$3,000 AND A SUSPENSION26OF THE LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT FOR 30 DAYS;

27 (3) FOR A THIRD VIOLATION, A FINE OF \$6,000 AND A SUSPENSION OF
28 THE LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT FOR 60 DAYS; AND

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1 (4) FOR ANY SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, REVOCATION OF THE LOCAL 2 DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT.

- 3 (L) THE HOLDER OF A LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT MAY NOT:
- 4 (1) SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; OR
- $\mathbf{5}$
- (2) STORE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR DELIVERY.

6 (M) (1) A PERSON SHALL APPLY TO THE LOCAL LICENSING BOARD FOR A 7 LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT BEFORE CONTRACTING TO DELIVER ALCOHOLIC 8 BEVERAGES FOR A RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER.

9 (2) IF A RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER CONTRACTS WITH A LOCAL 10 DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT HOLDER TO DELIVER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, THE 11 RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER AND THE LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT HOLDER 12 SHALL ESTABLISH A METHOD TO ENSURE THAT THE RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER 13 RETAINS CONTROL OVER SALES TO AND PAYMENTS MADE FROM A PURCHASER FOR 14 THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

15(N)THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO ENFORCE16THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2024.
