1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Cannabis Administration – Cannabis Licensing – Protests of Renewal**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain individuals to file a protest with the Maryland
4 Cannabis Administration against the renewal of a cannabis license; establishing
5 standards and requirements for the Administration’s consideration of a protest filed
6 under this Act; and generally relating to the renewal of cannabis licenses.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

15 **36–411.**

16 **(A) (1) A PROTEST AGAINST A LICENSE RENEWAL MAY BE FILED WITH**
17 **THE ADMINISTRATION BY AT LEAST 10 INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE:**

1 (I) RESIDENTS, COMMERCIAL TENANTS WHO ARE NOT
2 HOLDERS OF OR APPLICANTS FOR A LICENSE, OR REAL ESTATE OWNERS; AND

3 (II) LOCATED WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF THE LICENSED PREMISES.

4 (2) A PROTEST AGAINST A LICENSE RENEWAL SHALL:

5 (I) BE ON THE BASIS OF:

6 1. A VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE;

7 2. A VIOLATION OF CIVIL OR CRIMINAL LAW;

8 3. CONDUCT BY A LICENSEE THAT CREATES OR
9 MAINTAINS CONDITIONS THAT ALLOW OTHER INDIVIDUALS TO ACT IN A MANNER
10 THAT DISTURBS THE PUBLIC PEACE, INCLUDING:

11 A. OBSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY BY
12 UNRULY CROWDS;

13 B. ASSAULT, BATTERY, OR OTHER DISORDERLY
14 CONDUCT THAT DISTURBS THE PUBLIC PEACE;

15 C. VANDALISM; OR

16 D. LITTERING; OR

17 4. ANY OTHER VIOLATION ESTABLISHED BY THE
18 ADMINISTRATION BY REGULATION; AND

19 (II) BE SIGNED UNDER OATH.

20 (B) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
21 SUBSECTION, IF A PROTEST AGAINST A LICENSE RENEWAL IS FILED AT LEAST 30
22 DAYS BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT APPROVE THE
23 RENEWAL WITHOUT HOLDING A HEARING.

24 (2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY APPROVE A LICENSE RENEWAL
25 WITHOUT A HEARING IF THE ADMINISTRATION FINDS THAT THE BASIS OF THE
26 PROTEST FILED AGAINST THE RENEWAL LACKS SUBSTANCE.

27 (C) TO HEAR AND MAKE A DETERMINATION ON A PROTEST FILED AGAINST
28 A LICENSE RENEWAL, THE ADMINISTRATION:

1 **(1) MAY CONSIDER ONLY:**

2 **(I) ISSUES ARISING OUT OF SPECIFIC COMPLAINTS ABOUT THE**
3 **OPERATION OF THE LICENSED PREMISES; AND**

4 **(II) THE PERFORMANCE OF THE LICENSE HOLDER FOR THE**
5 **4-YEAR PERIOD IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE DATE OF THE RENEWAL**
6 **APPLICATION; AND**

7 **(2) MAY NOT CONSIDER ZONING ISSUES.**

8 **(D) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS**
9 **SECTION.**

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2024.
