12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That Section(s) 6–201 through 6–203 and the subtitle “Subtitle 2. Electronic Transactions
14 Protection Act” of Article – State Government of the Annotated Code of Maryland be
15 repealed.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 October 1, 2024.
