- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 4 [(h)] (I) (1) The Subcabinet may make grants to local school systems and 5 local law enforcement agencies from the Fund.
- 6 (2) The Subcabinet shall establish procedures for local school systems and 7 local law enforcement agencies to apply for grants from the Fund.
- 8 [(i)] (J) (1) The State Treasurer shall invest the money of the Fund in the 9 same manner as other State money may be invested.

- (2) Any interest earnings of the Fund shall be credited to the Fund.
- 11 [(j)] (K) Expenditures from the Fund may only be made:
- 12 (1) In accordance with the State budget; or

13 (2) By the budget amendment procedure as provided in § 7–209 of the State 14 Finance and Procurement Article, if at least 45 days have passed since the budget 15 amendment and supporting information were submitted to the budget committees for their 16 review and comment.

17 [(k)] (L) Money expended from the Fund by local school systems to enhance 18 school safety is supplemental to and is not intended to take the place of funding that 19 otherwise would be appropriated to local school systems.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 21 1, 2024.
