26	Medicine, shall study the impact of requiring the Maryland Medical Assistance Program to
27	provide comprehensive coverage for the treatment of obesity.
28	(c) In conducting the study, the Department shall:
29	(1) identify and compare the coverage for the treatment of obesity under
30	medical assistance programs and other public health programs in other states; and
31	(2) examine and estimate any potential savings that may result from
32	requiring comprehensive coverage for the treatment of obesity due to reductions in the use
33	of medications and services currently covered under the Maryland Medical Assistance
34	Program, including reductions in costs from weight-related comorbidities including
35	cardiovascular disease, hypertension, sleep apnea, depression, asthma, nonalcoholic fatty
36	<u>liver disease, Type 2 diabetes, knee and hip osteoarthritis, and gout.</u>

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1	(d) On or before December 31, 2024, the Maryland Department of Health shall
2	report its findings to the House Health and Government Operations Committee and the

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before June 1, 2025, 11 the Maryland Department of Health shall provide notice to Maryland Medical Assistance 12 Program recipients of the coverage required by this Act in writing, and prominently 13 positioned in any literature or correspondence sent to Program recipients about coverage 14 available under the Program in calendar year 2025.

October July 1, 2024.
