FOR the purpose of establishing the Individuals With Disabilities and Service–Disabled

Fund; establishing the qualifications for certain organizations to receive grants from
the Fund; authorizing the Governor to include in the annual budget bill a certain
appropriation for the Fund; and generally relating to the Individuals With
Disabilities and Service–Disabled Veterans Boating Fund.

## SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 3 INDICATED.

4 (B) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF DISABILITIES.

5 (C) "FUND" MEANS THE INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES AND 6 SERVICE–DISABLED VETERANS BOATING FUND.

7 (D) (1) "INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES" MEANS INDIVIDUALS 8 CONSIDERED DISABLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FEDERAL AMERICANS WITH 9 DISABILITIES ACT OF 1990, 42 U.S.C. § 12102.

10 (2) "INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES" INCLUDES INDIVIDUALS WITH 11 LEARNING DISABILITIES.

16 (A) THERE IS AN INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES AND 17 SERVICE–DISABLED VETERANS BOATING FUND.

18 **(B)** THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE SAILING, BOATING, 19 KAYAKING, CANOEING, AND PADDLEBOARDING PADDLEBOARDING, AND SURFING 20 OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES AND SERVICE-DISABLED 21 VETERANS.

22 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.

23 (D) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT 24 SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

25 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, 26 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

27 (E) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:

28 (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND; AND

5 (2) ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT IN 6 ADMINISTERING THE FUND.

7 (G) IN FISCAL YEAR 2026 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE 8 GOVERNOR MAY INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF 9 \$500,000 TO THE FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING THE STATE GRANTS UNDER 10 THIS SECTION.

11 (H) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE 12 DEPARTMENT MAY PROVIDE A GRANT OF NOT MORE THAN \$40,000 IN A FISCAL YEAR 13 TO A GRANTEE TO PROVIDE SAILING, BOATING, KAYAKING, CANOEING, <del>OR</del> 14 <del>PADDLEBOARDING</del> <u>PADDLEBOARDING</u>, OR <u>SURFING</u> OPPORTUNITIES FOR 15 INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES OR SERVICE-DISABLED VETERANS.

16(2)THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROVIDE GRANTS UNDER THIS SECTION17ONLY TO A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION IN GOOD STANDING THAT:

18 (I) IS QUALIFIED UNDER § 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL 19 REVENUE CODE;

20(II) HAS BEEN IN OPERATION FOR AT LEAST 3 YEARS,21NOTWITHSTANDING A CESSATION OF OPERATIONS DURING A NATIONAL OR PUBLIC22HEALTH EMERGENCY ISSUED:

231.BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES UNDER §24201, § 202(D), OR § 301 OF THE FEDERAL NATIONAL EMERGENCIES ACT; OR

25 **2.** BY THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND HUMAN 26 SERVICES UNDER THE FEDERAL PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE ACT; AND

(III) HAS ENGAGED INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES OR
 SERVICE-DISABLED VETERANS IN SAILING, BOATING, KAYAKING, CANOEING, <del>OR</del>
 <del>PADDLEBOARDING</del> <u>PADDLEBOARDING</u>, <u>OR</u> <u>SURFING</u> ACTIVITIES ON <del>THE</del>
 <del>CHESAPEAKE BAY OR ITS TRIBUTARIES</del> <u>STATE WATERS</u> AT LEAST 25 TIMES IN EACH
 OF THE PAST 3 YEARS.
