A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Safety – Police Accountability and Discipline – Summary Punishment**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the imposition of certain summary punishment of a police
4 officer under certain circumstances; and generally relating to police accountability
5 and discipline.

8 Section 3–106.1

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Public Safety**

14 **3–106.1.**

15 **(A) THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT PROHIBIT SUMMARY PUNISHMENT BY**
16 **HIGHER RANKING POLICE OFFICERS AS DESIGNATED BY THE CHIEF.**

17 **(B) SUMMARY PUNISHMENT MAY BE IMPOSED FOR A MINOR VIOLATION OF**
18 **LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY RULES AND REGULATIONS IF THE FACTS THAT**
19 **CONSTITUTE THE MINOR VIOLATION ARE NOT IN DISPUTE.**

20 **(C) SUMMARY PUNISHMENT MAY NOT EXCEED A WRITTEN REPRIMAND.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 **(D) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE RELATING TO POLICE**
2 **ACCOUNTABILITY BOARDS, ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGING COMMITTEES, AND TRIAL**
3 **BOARDS DO NOT APPLY TO THE IMPOSITION OF SUMMARY PUNISHMENT.**

4 **(E) SUMMARY PUNISHMENT IS NOT APPEALABLE BY THE POLICE OFFICER.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2024.
