Maryland Historical Trust – Historical and Cultural Museum Assistance Program – Funding
FOR the purpose of <u>altering prohibitions on grants from the Maryland Historical Trust</u> , authorizing the Governor to include a certain appropriation in the annual budget bill to the <u>Maryland Historical</u> Trust to be used to provide grants to museums under the Historical and Cultural Museum Assistance Program; and generally relating to funding for the Historical and Cultural Museum Assistance Program.
BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – State Finance and Procurement Section 5A–352, 5A–353(a) and (b), 5A–354 through 5A–356, 5A–355, and 5A–358 Annotated Code of Maryland (2021 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement)


