- 1 (2) Of the 15 Board members: 2 (i) 3 shall be licensed audiologists who have at least 5 years' paid work experience in audiology and are currently practicing audiology in the State; 3 4 Subject to subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph, the Governor (5)shall appoint the audiologist members, with the advice of the Secretary, from a list 5 submitted to the Secretary and the Governor by the [Board] MARYLAND ACADEMY OF 6 7 AUDIOLOGY. 8 The number of names on the list shall be at least 3 times the (ii) 9 number of vacancies. 10 For each audiologist vacancy, the Board shall notify all licensed (iii) audiologists in the State of the vacancy to solicit nominations to fill the vacancy. 11
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2024.
