33	(a) In this section, "performing arts theater" means an area, a building, or a
34	structure designed and used for plays, acts, dramas, concerts, or histrionics by actors or
35	actresses performing on a stage or the showing of movies or films.

- 1 There is a performing arts theater beer and wine license. (b) 2 The Board may issue the license for use on the premises of a performing arts 3 theater operated by a nonprofit organization. The license authorizes the holder to sell or serve beer and wine at retail for 4 (d) 5 on-premises consumption. 6 The license holder may sell or serve beer and wine: (e) 7 1 hour before and after a performance: (1) $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$ during a performance: 8 9 $\frac{(3)}{(3)}$ during an intermission; and 10 (4) during a reception 1 hour before or 1 hour after a performance. The license may not be transferred to another location. 11 (f) The license holder shall purchase beer and wine from an authorized and 12 13 licensed wholesaler. Issuance of a license under this section does not prohibit the Board from 14 (h) 15 issuing a Class C per diem license that applies to the performing arts theater. The license holder shall serve or offer for sale snacks at all times when beer 16 (i) 17 and wine are sold. The annual license fee is \$500.1 18 (i) 19 22-1005.2. 20 IN THIS SECTION, "PERFORMING ARTS NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION" 21 MEANS A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT ORGANIZES THE PRODUCTION OF PLAYS. 22ACTS, DRAMAS, CONCERTS, OR SIMILAR EVENTS BY INDIVIDUALS PERFORMING ON A STAGE OR THE SHOWING OF FILMS. 23
- 24 (B) THERE IS A PERFORMING ARTS NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION BEER, 25 WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 26 (C) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE TO A PERFORMING ARTS 27 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.

- 1 (D) (1) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO SELL OR SERVE BEER,
- 2 WINE, AND LIQUOR AT RETAIL FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION AT UP TO THREE
- 3 LOCATIONS DESIGNATED AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION.

- 13 (E) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL OR SERVE BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR:
- 14 (1) 1 HOUR BEFORE AND AFTER A PERFORMANCE;
- 15 (2) DURING A PERFORMANCE;
- 16 (3) DURING AN INTERMISSION; AND
- 17 (4) DURING A RECEPTION WITHIN 1 HOUR BEFORE OR AFTER A
- 18 **PERFORMANCE.**
- 19 (F) THE LICENSE MAY NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER LOCATION NOT
- 20 IDENTIFIED ON THE APPLICATION.
- 21 (G) THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL PURCHASE BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR
- 22 FROM A RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER OR AN AUTHORIZED AND LICENSED WHOLESALER.
- 23 (H) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY NOT SELL OR ISSUE MORE THAN 750 TICKETS
- 24 TO ANY EVENT OR PERFORMANCE AT WHICH THE HOLDER WILL SELL OR SERVE
- 25 BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR.
- 26 (I) ISSUANCE OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE
- 27 BOARD FROM ISSUING A CLASS C PER DIEM LICENSE TO THE PERFORMING ARTS
- 28 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION FOR AN EVENT OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF THE LICENSE.
- 29 (J) THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL SERVE OR OFFER FOR SALE SNACKS AT
- 30 ALL TIMES WHEN BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ARE SOLD.

5	BOARD, OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, REPORT ON THE FORM THAT THE
6	COMPTROLLER OR, THE BOARD, OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REQUIRES
7	INFORMATION RELATING TO THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES THAT ARE THE SUBJECT
8	OF THE RECORDS REQUIRED TO BE KEPT; AND
9	(III) ON REQUEST OF THE COMPTROLLER OR, THE BOARD, OR
