- 6 (C) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY HOLD ANOTHER LICENSE OR PERMIT
 7 ISSUED BY THE BOARD TO SELL PRODUCTS THE HOLDER PRODUCES TO THE EXTENT

- 22 (F) THE LICENSE HOLDER IS NOT REQUIRED TO SELL FOOD BUT IS 23 REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PREPACKAGED SNACKS.
- 24 (G) THE HOURS OF SALE FOR A CLASS L BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE 25 ARE THE SAME AS THOSE FOR THE UNDERLYING MANUFACTURER'S LICENSE.
- 26 (H) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$3,000.
