1 AN ACT concerning

Public Senior Higher Education Institutions – Pregnant and Parenting Students – Policy Requirements (Pregnant and Parenting Support Act)

FOR the purpose of requiring each public senior higher education institution to adopt a policy regarding pregnant and parenting students using certain guidelines; requiring each public senior higher education institution to post the policy on the institution's website; and generally relating to pregnant and parenting students and public senior higher education institutions.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 20 INDICATED.

21 (2) "PREGNANT AND PARENTING STUDENT" MEANS A STUDENT 22 ENROLLED AT A PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION WHO:

- (I) IS PREGNANT; OR

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(II) EXERCISES CARE, CUSTODY, OR CONTROL OVER A CHILD.

2 (3) "PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION" HAS THE 3 MEANING STATED IN § 15–136 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

4 (B) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT ALL STUDENTS AT AN 5 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE, REGARDLESS OF THEIR 6 GENDER, SHALL ENJOY FREEDOM FROM DISCRIMINATION OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING 7 PREGNANCY DISCRIMINATION AS DESCRIBED IN TITLE IX OF THE EDUCATION 8 AMENDMENTS OF 1972.

9 (C) (1) EACH PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION SHALL 10 ADOPT A POLICY REGARDING PREGNANT AND PARENTING STUDENTS THAT IS 11 CONSISTENT WITH TITLE IX OF THE FEDERAL HIGHER EDUCATION ACT.

12 (2) THE POLICY REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 13 SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:

192.THE CHILD CARE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM;

20 **3.** THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM;

214.THE MARYLAND CHILDREN'S HEALTH INSURANCE22PROGRAM; AND

235.ANYOTHERPROGRAMS,SCHOLARSHIPS,OR24SUBSIDIES FOR PREGNANT AND PARENTING STUDENTS;

25(II)THE PROVISION OF INFORMATION ABOUT OR REFERRALS26TO RESOURCES REGARDING ADOPTION SERVICES;

(III) THE AVAILABILITY OF INSTITUTIONAL ACCOMMODATIONS
 FOR PREGNANT AND PARENTING STUDENTS, INCLUDING PRIORITY CLASS
 REGISTRATION AND FLEXIBLE SCHEDULING OPTIONS; AND

1(IV)A REFERRAL NETWORK OF ON-CAMPUS AND OFF-CAMPUS2HEALTH CARE SERVICE PROVIDERS.

3 (D) ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2025, EACH PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER 4 EDUCATION INSTITUTION SHALL POST THE POLICY ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION 5 (C) OF THIS SECTION ON THE INSTITUTION'S WEBSITE.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 7 1, 2024.
