- 26 **SUBSECTION, THE** fee for a Class C per diem beer, wine, and liquor license is \$50 per day.
- 27 (2) FOR A 1-DAY EVENT WITH MORE THAN 1,000 ATTENDEES, THE
- 28 FEE FOR A CLASS C PER DIEM BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE IS \$1,000.
