(1) By September 15 of the calendar year in which the qualified capital expenses are paid or incurred, an AN individual or a corporation WHO PAID OR INCURRED QUALIFIED CAPITAL EXPENSES DURING THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR may submit an application to the Department for a grant authorized

4 5 6 7	(ii) If the total amount of grants applied for under this section exceeds the maximum specified under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph, the Department shall approve a grant for each applicant in an amount equal to the product of multiplying the amount applied for by the applicant times a fraction:
8 9	1. the numerator of which is the maximum specified under subparagraph (i) of this paragraph; and
10 11	2. the denominator of which is the total of all grants applied for by all applicants for that calendar year.
