1 AN ACT concerning

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Arts Incubator Workgroup - Established

FOR the purpose of establishing the Arts Incubator Workgroup to study how arts and
cultural institutions can support local artists; and generally relating to the Arts
Incubator Workgroup.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 7 That:

- 8 (a) There is an Arts Incubator Workgroup.
- 9 (b) The Workgroup consists of the following members:
- 10 (1) one individual, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- 11 (2) one individual, appointed by the Speaker of the House; and
- 12 (3) the following members, appointed by the Governor:
- 13 (i) two three artists;
- 14 (ii) one artist who is an arts educator;

15 (iii) one representative of an arts entity that can accommodate an 16 audience of at least 50 people but not more than 250 people;

17 18 19 20 21 22	(g) (1) On or before October 1, 2024 January 1, 2025, the Workgroup shall submit a preliminary report on its recommendations, including any necessary budget, facilities, or in-kind services that are needed or could be used to support local artists findings, including research, case studies, and examples of approaches used to support artists in other areas, to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.

It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 6 months and, at the end of December 31, 2025, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

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
