- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Somerset County to enact local laws and adopt other measures to manage, direct, and regulate fire, rescue, and 4  $\mathbf{5}$ emergency medical services in the County; authorizing the County Commissioners 6 to authorize or create an entity or a body to administer the County's affairs in the 7 County relating to fire, rescue, and emergency medical services; requiring the County Commissioners to establish an Emergency Services Advisory Council to 8 9 make certain recommendations under certain circumstances; and generally relating 10 to fire, rescue, and emergency medical services in Somerset County.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article 20 Somerset County
- 20 Title 4. [Fire Departments and Fire Marshal] **EMERGENCY SERVICES**.

3 (A) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY ENACT LOCAL LAWS AND ADOPT
4 OTHER MEASURES NECESSARY TO ADEQUATELY AND APPROPRIATELY MANAGE,
5 DIRECT, AND REGULATE FIRE, RESCUE, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES IN
6 THE COUNTY.

7 (B) (1) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY AUTHORIZE OR CREATE AN 8 ENTITY OR A BODY TO ADMINISTER THE COUNTY'S AFFAIRS RELATING TO FIRE, 9 RESCUE, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND ASSOCIATED ACTIVITIES WHILE 10 MAINTAINING THE VOLUNTEER EMERGENCY SERVICES.

11 (2) IF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZE OR CREATE AN 12 ENTITY OR A BODY UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE COUNTY 13 COMMISSIONERS SHALL ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY SERVICES ADVISORY 14 COUNCIL TO PROVIDE THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS WITH RECOMMENDATIONS 15 REGARDING THE OPERATIONS OF FIRE SUPPRESSION, EMERGENCY MEDICAL, AND 16 HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SERVICES IN THE COUNTY.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2024.
