- FOR the purpose of altering the application of provisions of law that prohibit an individual from simultaneously being a candidate for more than one public office or office of a political party; prohibiting individuals from simultaneously being a candidate for, or holding, a party office and an elected public office; and generally relating to simultaneous candidacy for and incumbency in more than one office.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 22 (a) In this article the following words have the meanings indicated unless a 23 different meaning is clearly intended from the context.
- 24 (l-1) (1) "Central committee" means a political committee for a political party

- 1 established under Title 4 of this article.
- 2 (2) "Central committee" includes a political committee for a political party 3 that engages in campaign finance activity that is subject to Title 13 of this article.
- 4 (hh) "Political party" means an organized group that is qualified as a political party 5 in accordance with Title 4 of this article.

- 7 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO 8 SIMULTANEOUSLY HOLDS AN ELECTED PUBLIC OFFICE AND:
- 9 (1) IS ON THE BALLOT FOR THE NATIONAL PRESIDENTIAL 10 NOMINATING CONVENTION; OR
- 11 (2) HOLDS THE OFFICE OF DELEGATE TO THE NATIONAL 12 PRESIDENTIAL NOMINATING CONVENTION.
- [(a)] (B) An individual simultaneously may not be a candidate for more than one ELECTED public office.
- 15 **[(b)] (C)** An individual simultaneously may not be a candidate for more than one 16 office of a political party.
- [(c)] (D) [Unless otherwise prohibited by rule of the applicable political party, an] AN individual simultaneously may NOT be a candidate for a party office and [a] AN ELECTED public office.
- 20 **(E)** AN INDIVIDUAL SIMULTANEOUSLY MAY NOT HOLD A PARTY OFFICE AND 21 AN ELECTED PUBLIC OFFICE.

- 23 (a) Delegates and alternate delegates to the national presidential nominating convention of a political party shall be selected as provided in the national party rules of the party.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 2025.
