- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 Article – Public Utilities

- 20 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 21 (k) "Qualified offshore wind project" means a wind turbine electricity generation
- 22 facility, including the associated transmission-related interconnection facilities and
- 23 equipment, that:

2 3	(i) on the outer continental shelf of the Atlantic Ocean in an area that the United States Department of the Interior designates for leasing; and
4 5 6	(ii) more than 10 miles off the coast of the State for a project selected under § 7–704.4 of this subtitle or approved under § 7–704.1 of this subtitle after June 1, 2023; and
7	(2) interconnects to the PJM Interconnection grid[:
8	(i) at a point located on the Delmarva Peninsula; or
9 10	(ii)] through an offshore wind transmission project selected under § 7–704.3 of this subtitle.
11 12	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
