- FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Insurance Administration to study professional
 employer organizations in the State; and generally relating to health coverage and
 professional employer organizations.
- 7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,8 That:
- 9 (a) The Maryland Insurance Administration shall study professional employer 10 organizations in the State.
- 11 (b) In conducting the study, the Administration shall:
- 12 (1) identify and compare the regulation of professional employer 13 organizations under federal and State law and in other states;
- 14 (2) review the history of professional employer organization activities in 15 the State and elsewhere and changes to the professional employer organization industry 16 over time;
- 17 (3) review professional employer organization health plans and plan 18 benefit designs;

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1 (4) review membership and other requirements that businesses must meet 2 to participate in professional employer organization arrangements and to access 3 professional employer organization health plans;

4 (5) examine the regulatory structures for health insurance and 5 professional employer organizations in other states <u>and under federal law</u> that allow 6 individuals who are co-employed through a professional employer organization 7 arrangement and have a workplace employer that is a small employer to participate in the 8 professional employer organization's large group plan; and

9 (6) <u>determine the address any</u> potential <u>impact impacts</u> of proposed 10 statutory changes in the State relating to the offering of health coverage by professional 11 employer organizations on the small group market in the State.

12 (c) On or before December 31, 2024, the Maryland Insurance Administration 13 shall report its findings to the House Health and Government Operations Committee and 14 the Senate Finance Committee in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government 15 Article.
