FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to conduct a certain study examining certain data regarding an individual's residence prior to incarceration and on release from a State correctional facility; and generally relating to State correctional facilities.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

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- 17 (A) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2025, AND EACH OCTOBER 1 THEREAFTER,
- 18 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONDUCT A STUDY ON THE LOCATION OF INDIVIDUALS
- 19 BEFORE AND FOLLOWING INCARCERATION IN A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY
- 20 AND REPORT THE RESULTS OF THE STUDY TO THE SENATE JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS
- 21 COMMITTEE, THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE, THE HOUSE
- 22 JUDICIARY COMMITTEE, AND THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE, IN
- 23 ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

(B) THE STUDY SHALL INCLUDE:

1	(1) DATA ON THE COUNTY OF RESIDENCE OF EACH INDIVIDUAL
2	RELEASED DURING THE PREVIOUS YEAR, AS REPORTED BY THE INDIVIDUAL ON
3	INTAKE TO THE FACILITY:

- 4 (2) DATA ON THE COUNTY OF RELEASE FOLLOWING INCARCERATION;
- 5 (3) FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO WERE TRANSFERRED FROM ONE STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY TO ANOTHER PRIOR TO RELEASE, THE NUMBER OF DAYS THAT THE TRANSFER OCCURRED BEFORE RELEASE; AND
- 8 (4) A COMPARISON OF:
- 9 (I) THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS RELEASED FROM A STATE 10 CORRECTIONAL FACILITY INTO THE SAME COUNTY IN WHICH THEY RESIDED PRIOR 11 TO INCARCERATION;
- 12 (II) THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS RELEASED FROM A STATE
 13 CORRECTIONAL FACILITY INTO THE SAME COUNTY IN WHICH CONVICTION
 14 OCCURRED; AND
- 15 (III) THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS RELEASED FROM A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY INTO THE COUNTY IN WHICH THEY WERE INCARCERATED AT THE TIME OF RELEASE.
