 or contracting with an individual to provide surgical technology services unless the
 individual completes certain educational requirements and holds a certain credential
 or provides documentation of certain training or employment; requiring a hospital
 or an ambulatory surgical facility to submit to the Maryland Department of Health,
 on request, certain documentation related to surgical technologists; and generally
 relating to surgical technologists.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

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1 SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY SERVICES.

2 (C) (1) "SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY SERVICE" MEANS A SERVICE PROVIDED 3 AS PART OF A PATIENT'S SURGERY.

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(2) "SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY SERVICE" INCLUDES:

5 (I) 1. PREPARING AN OPERATING ROOM AND STERILE 6 OPERATING FIELD FOR SURGICAL PROCEDURES BY ENSURING SURGICAL 7 EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR EACH SCHEDULED PROCEDURE ARE 8 AVAILABLE AND FUNCTIONING PROPERLY; AND

9 2. PROPERLY AND SAFELY USING STERILE TECHNIQUES 10 TO PREPARE SURGICAL SUPPLIES, INSTRUMENTS, AND EQUIPMENT;

11 (II) ANTICIPATING AND RESPONDING TO THE NEEDS OF A 12 SURGEON AND OTHER SURGICAL TEAM MEMBERS BY MONITORING THE STERILE 13 OPERATING FIELD IN AN OPERATING ROOM AND PROVIDING THE REQUIRED 14 INSTRUMENTS OR SUPPLIES; AND

15 (III) PERFORMING TASKS AT A STERILE OPERATING FIELD AS
 16 DIRECTED, INCLUDING:

171.PASSING SURGICAL SUPPLIES, INSTRUMENTS, OR18EQUIPMENT DIRECTLY TO A SURGEON OR SURGICAL TEAM MEMBER;

25 (3) "SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY SERVICE" DOES NOT INCLUDE A 26 SERVICE THE PERFORMANCE OF WHICH REQUIRES A LICENSE OR OTHER 27 AUTHORIZATION UNDER THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.

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1 THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROHIBIT:

2 (1) A LICENSED HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER FROM PERFORMING 3 SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY SERVICES IF THE PRACTITIONER IS ACTING WITHIN THE 4 SCOPE OF THE PRACTITIONER'S LICENSE; OR

5 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL FROM PERFORMING SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY 6 SERVICES IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS A STUDENT OR AN INTERN WHO IS UNDER THE 7 DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER ACTING WITHIN THE 8 SCOPE OF THE PRACTITIONER'S LICENSE.

10 THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY WITH RESPECT TO SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY 11 SERVICES OFFERED BY AN INDIVIDUAL:

12 (1) DURING INTERVENTIONAL CARDIAC RADIOLOGY;

13(2)PROVIDING DENTAL AUXILIARY SERVICES AS DELEGATED AND14SUPERVISED BY A LICENSED DENTIST; OR

15(3)ASSISTING WITH OPTOMETRY OR OPHTHALMIC SERVICES UNDER16THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED OPTOMETRIST.

26HOLDS **(II)** AND MAINTAINS Α CERTIFIED SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST CREDENTIAL ADMINISTERED BY A NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED 2728SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST CERTIFYING BODY ACCREDITED BY THE NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR CERTIFYING AGENCIES AND RECOGNIZED BY THE AMERICAN 2930 **COLLEGE OF SURGEONS AND THE ASSOCIATION OF SURGICAL TECHNOLOGISTS;**

31 (2) **PROVIDES DOCUMENTATION OF SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF A**

SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST TRAINING PROGRAM IN THE UNITED STATES ARMED
 FORCES; OR
 (3) PROVIDES DOCUMENTATION OF EMPLOYMENT PROVIDING

3 (3) PROVIDES DOCUMENTATION OF EMPLOYMENT PROVIDING 4 SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY SERVICES ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2025, IN:

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(I) A HOSPITAL LICENSED UNDER § 19–319 OF THIS TITLE; OR

6 (II) AN AMBULATORY SURGICAL FACILITY LICENSED UNDER § 7 19–3B–02 OF THIS TITLE.

8 (B) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A HOSPITAL 9 OR AN AMBULATORY SURGICAL FACILITY MAY EMPLOY OR CONTRACT WITH AN 10 INDIVIDUAL TO PROVIDE SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY SERVICES FOR THE 18–MONTH 11 PERIOD IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE INDIVIDUAL'S SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION 12 OF:

13(I)A SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM AS REQUIRED UNDER14SUBSECTION (A)(1)(I) OF THIS SECTION; OR

15 (II) FROM A PROGRAM ACCREDITED AS A LETTER OF REVIEW 16 PROGRAM BY THE COMMISSION ON ACCREDITATION OF ALLIED HEALTH 17 EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

18 (2) A HOSPITAL OR AN AMBULATORY SURGICAL FACILITY MAY NOT 19 CONTINUE TO EMPLOY OR CONTRACT WITH AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) 20 OF THIS SUBSECTION BEYOND THE 18-MONTH PERIOD UNLESS THE INDIVIDUAL 21 PROVIDES DOCUMENTATION TO THE HOSPITAL OR AMBULATORY SURGICAL 22 FACILITY THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAS OBTAINED THE CREDENTIALS REQUIRED 23 UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1)(II) OF THIS SECTION.

25(A) THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT PROHIBIT A HOSPITAL OR AN AMBULATORY 26SURGICAL FACILITY WITH AN EMPLOYMENT OR OTHER CONTRACTUAL 27RELATIONSHIP WITH A SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST FROM **ESTABLISHING** 28ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE INDIVIDUAL AS A CONDITION OF 29EMPLOYMENT OR OF THE CONTRACT.

30 (B) IF AN EMPLOYEE DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS 31 SUBTITLE, A HOSPITAL OR AN AMBULATORY SURGICAL FACILITY MAY RESTRICT AN 32 EMPLOYEE'S ELIGIBILITY TO PROVIDE SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY SERVICES, AS 33 DETERMINED APPROPRIATE BY THE HOSPITAL OR AMBULATORY SURGICAL

3 ON REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT, A HOSPITAL OR AN AMBULATORY 4 SURGICAL FACILITY THAT EMPLOYS OR CONTRACTS WITH A SURGICAL 5 TECHNOLOGIST SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT DOCUMENTATION 6 DEMONSTRATING THAT THE SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH 7 THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2024.
