- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 Article - Natural Resources

- 20 4-512.
- During the open season for migratory waterfowl, a person may not fish by any means
- 22 within 500 yards of any stationary blind or blind site which is occupied and is being used
- 23 for hunting migratory waterfowl.
- 24 8-701.



- 1 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 2 (s) (1) "Vessel" means every description of watercraft, including an ice boat 3 but not including a seaplane, that is used or capable of being used as a means of
- 4 transportation on water or ice.
- 5 (2) "Vessel" includes the motor, spars, sails, and accessories of a vessel.

- 7 DURING THE OPEN SEASON FOR MIGRATORY WATERFOWL, A PERSON MAY NOT
- 8 OPERATE A VESSEL IN ANY MANNER WITHIN 500 YARDS OF ANY STATIONARY BLIND
- 9 OR BLIND SITE THAT IS OCCUPIED AND BEING USED FOR HUNTING MIGRATORY
- 10 WATERFOWL.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 12 1, 2024.
