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Grow Your Own Educators Grant Program – Established

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Grow Your Own Educators Grant Program to provide grants to certain local school systems for certain employees who pledge to fulfill a 4 $\mathbf{5}$ certain service obligation as a full-time teacher in the State; requiring the State 6 Department of Education to administer the Program and to take certain actions to 7 develop and implement the program; establishing the eligibility for certain teacher 8 candidates in the Program and requiring teacher candidates to be paid a certain rate 9 and offered certain benefits under the Program; requiring collaboratives to take 10 certain actions under the Program; requiring authorizing the Governor to include a 11 certain an appropriation in the annual budget bill for the Program; requiring the 12 Department to collect and publish on its website certain data on the Program each 13year; and generally relating to the Grow Your Own Educators Grant Program.
