3 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A 4 CUSTODIAN SHALL DENY INSPECTION OF A REPORT FILED WITH THE STATE 5 DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION UNDER § 1–210 OF THE 6 CORPORATIONS AND ASSOCIATIONS ARTICLE.

7 (B) A CUSTODIAN SHALL ALLOW INSPECTION BY A UNIT OF STATE 8 GOVERNMENT IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE UNIT'S OFFICIAL DUTIES.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a reporting entity formed 10 before the effective date of this Act shall file the report required by § 1–210 of the 11 Corporations and Associations Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, on or before 12 October 1, 2025.

13 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 October 1, 2024.
