- 1 (1) ESTABLISH A PROCESS TO PHASE OUT AND, ON OR BEFORE
- 2 DECEMBER 31, 2026, PROHIBIT THE USE OF LEAD OR LEAD-BASED AMMUNITION
- 3 FOR HUNTING;
- 4 (2) ESTABLISH A PROCESS TO CERTIFY AMMUNITION AS NONLEAD
- 5 AMMUNITION; AND
- 6 (3) ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION.
- 7 (C) THE PROCESS TO PHASE OUT LEAD OR LEAD-BASED AMMUNITION 8 SHALL PRIORITIZE DEER HUNTING.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2024.
